Background

Created in the frame of the Comorelp project and led by the Lifelong Learning Platform, the EU Policy Lab is inspired by a “*co-creation participatory exercise*” (from [JRC Policy Lab approach](#)) “*designed to foster creativity and engagement to develop interactions, processes and tools contributing to bringing innovation in the European policy-making*”. Its goals are to **foster cooperation among EU regions in the field of lifelong learning** and to improve the exchange of knowledge and practice on **monitoring and evaluation of lifelong learning policies**.

The EU policy lab is meant to gather **experts** (EU and international organisations, national authorities, researchers..) and **regional stakeholders** (policy-makers, education and training stakeholders organisations, representatives of learners and grassroots stakeholders and civil society representatives).
